

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

~POLAND LOCAL SCHOOLS~

Registration for children entering Poland Local Schools Kindergarten this fall will be held on two consecutive Saturdays – **March 4, 2017 & March 11, 2017**. Children presently enrolled in our Union Kindergartens do not re-register for first grade.

All Kindergarten registrations will be held at Union Elementary School at 30 Riverside Drive. Registration will be from 9:00AM – Noon on both Saturdays. You will be able to register your children for the Preschool & Afterschool Care Programs that are held at North Elementary on these dates. New students entering Poland Schools next fall, in Grades 1-4, may register at this time also. It is not necessary to bring your child or siblings to the registration process.

Parents or guardians must provide the following information, please bring originals. *It is imperative that you bring these items at the time of registration, we cannot register without them:*

1. **The child's original, raised seal, birth certificate & Social Security Card**
2. **The child's immunization records**
3. **Proof of residency** (mortgage documents, house closing papers, or rental agreement)
4. **Parent identification** (drivers license & 2 current utility bills or credit card statements)
5. **If applicable, custody papers**

Please be advised that no registration papers will be given out before March 4th.

A child entering Kindergarten must be five years of age on or before August 1st to be eligible for admission. Those entering first grade must be six years of age on or before August 1st. If your child attended another school for Kindergarten and has a birthday after August 1st, you will be referred to the school psychologist before your child is enrolled.

A screening program is planned for April 3-4, 2017. Parents will be given an appointment time for the screening during the registration process. It is important that all incoming kindergarten students are registered and screened. For questions, please call the Union Elementary School Secretary, Mrs. Morrow, at 330-757-7014.
